Provost's Fund for Innovation in Research

Supports research activities across three broad areas

- \$1.8M Seed funding for emerging research, targeting the Research Pentagon
- Dissemination of research
- Research infrastructure

Major Objectives

- Development of interdisciplinary research teams
- Increase extramural funding
- Submission of center-scale grant proposals
- Supporting research activities in the Scholarship Agenda



Faculty Research Grants

Emerging Research Grants

- Support research in emerging areas with potential for support from external sources
- Up to \$10,000 for one year
- Single investigator
- All tenured or tenure-track faculty are eligible
- Submission Deadline – November 1, 2022
- Post-award report due within 30 days of project end date

Faculty Research Grants

Big Idea Research Grants

Phase 1	Phase 2	Phase 3
up to \$10,000	up to \$75,000	up to \$125,000 / year
12 months	12 months	up to 24 months

- All tenured or tenure-track faculty are eligible
- Submission Deadline – November 1, 2022
- Post-award report due within 30 days of project end date
- Expected Deliverables include applications for external funding. Phase 3 projects must target center-scale funding.



Council on Research Summer Stipend

- \$6,000 summer salary support
- Assistant Professors, 9-month appointment only are eligible
- Submission Deadline – January 17, 2023
- Project Start – July 1, 2023
- Post-award report due within 30 days of end date

Faculty Travel Grants

- Provides up to \$1,000 for domestic or international travel
- 1:1 match required
- All tenured and tenure-track faculty are eligible

Travel Dates	Submission Deadline
September, October, November	August 15, 2022
December, January, February	October 1, 2022
March, April, May	January 17, 2023
June, July, August	April 1, 2023



Arts/Humanities Project Support Fund

- Provides up to \$3,000 in support of costs related to scholarly or artistic work
- Tenure or tenure-track faculty in the following colleges are eligible to apply:
 - College of Art & Design
 - EJ Ourso College of Business
 - College of Humanities & Social Sciences
 - College of Human Sciences & Education
 - Manship School of Mass Communication
 - College of Music & Dramatic Arts
- Submission Deadline – Minimum of 60 days prior to project start date
- Funds must be spent in same fiscal year as award



Conference Support Fund

- Established to encourage hosting academic conferences, symposia, lectureship series, or meetings of a regional, national or international organization at LAMC (potential or get LAMC into



Equipment Repair Fund

- Provides funding for the repair of research related equipment
- Proposals including 1:1 match will be prioritized
- All tenured and tenure-track faculty are eligible
- Original equipment acquisition cost must exceed \$5,000
- Official quote for repair costs must be included with proposal
