## U.S. Department of Education 30-day Reporting Requirement May 19, 2020

LSU signed the funding certification and agreement for the Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act on April 13, 2020 and plans to use the funds to provide the mandated amount of at least 50% of the emergency financial aid grants to students.

LSU will receive \$9,441,144 (50%) of the total Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) dollars allocated to the university for emergency student aid.

We understand this last semester has been challenging dealing with COVID-19 and the disruption to campus. You have been awarded LSU CARES Act funding based on your demonstrated financial need. Funding will either be direct deposited into your bank account on file with the Bursar's Office, or you will receive a check mailed to your local mailing address if you do not have a bank account on file.
