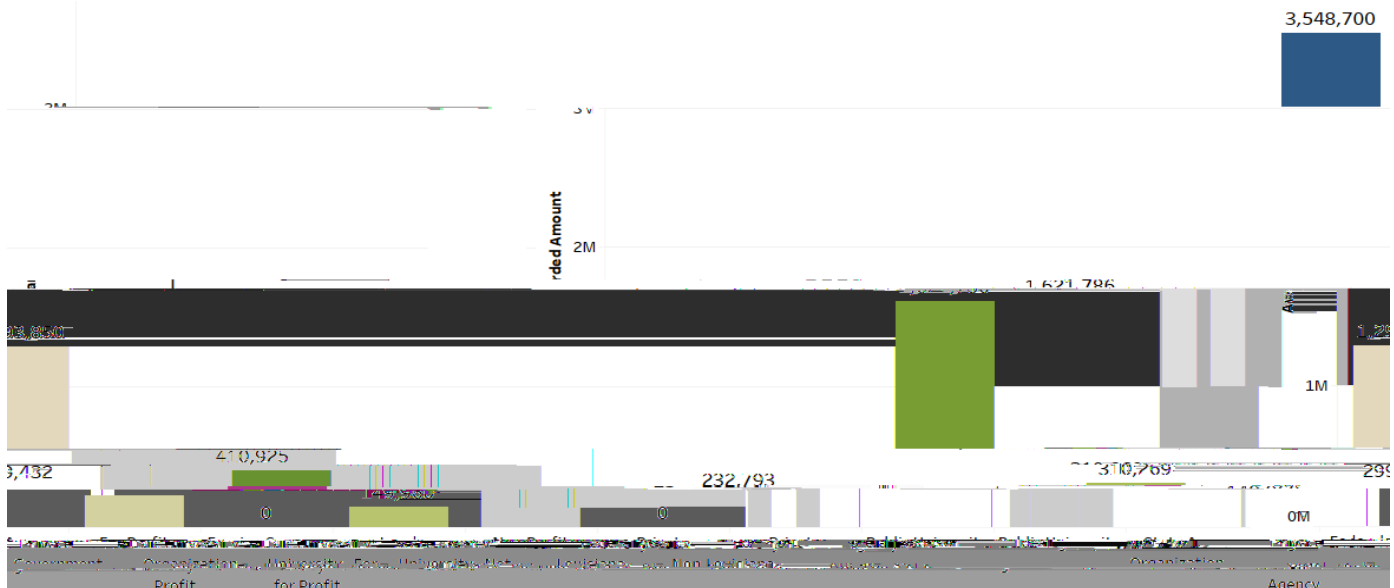

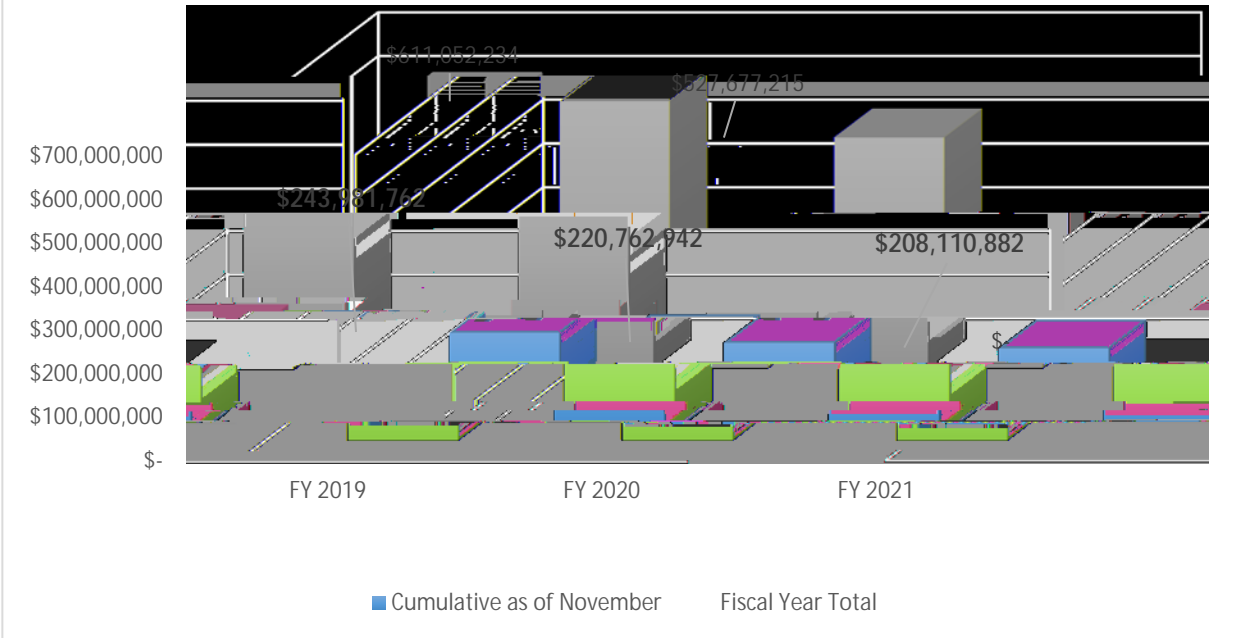

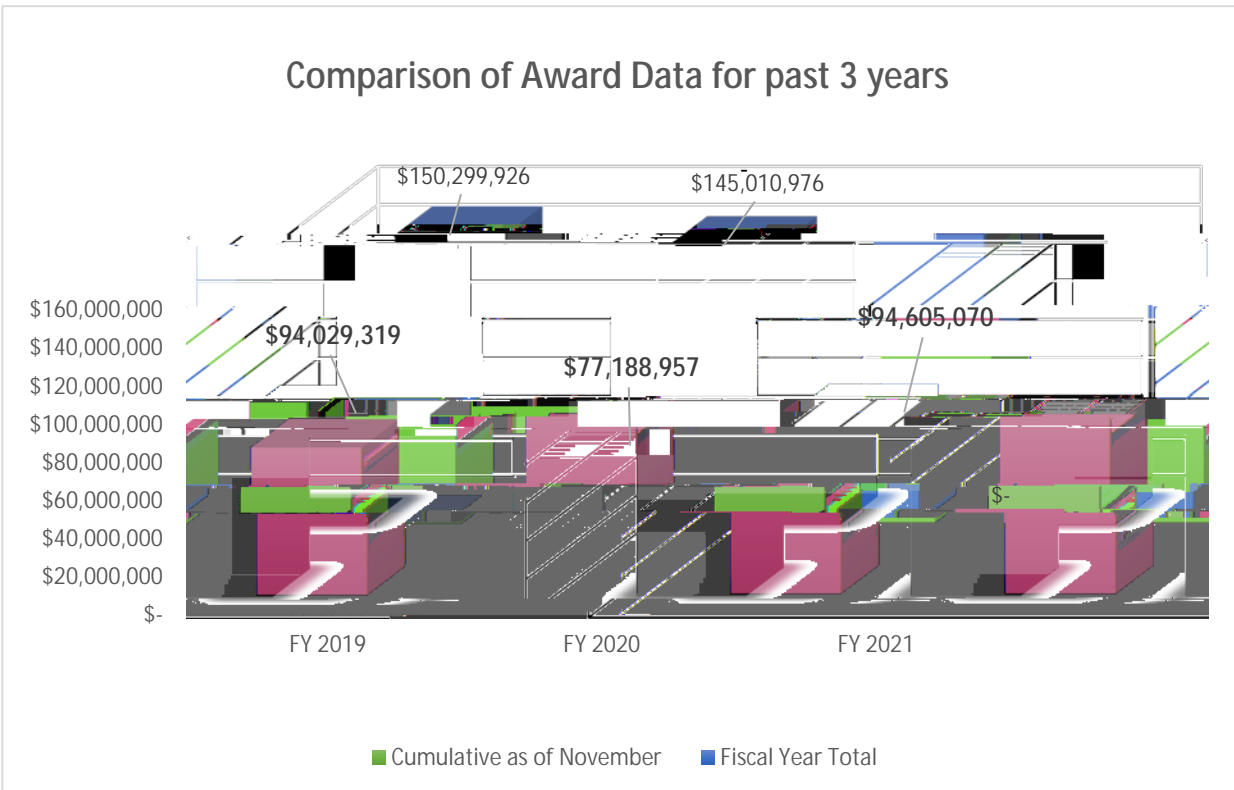


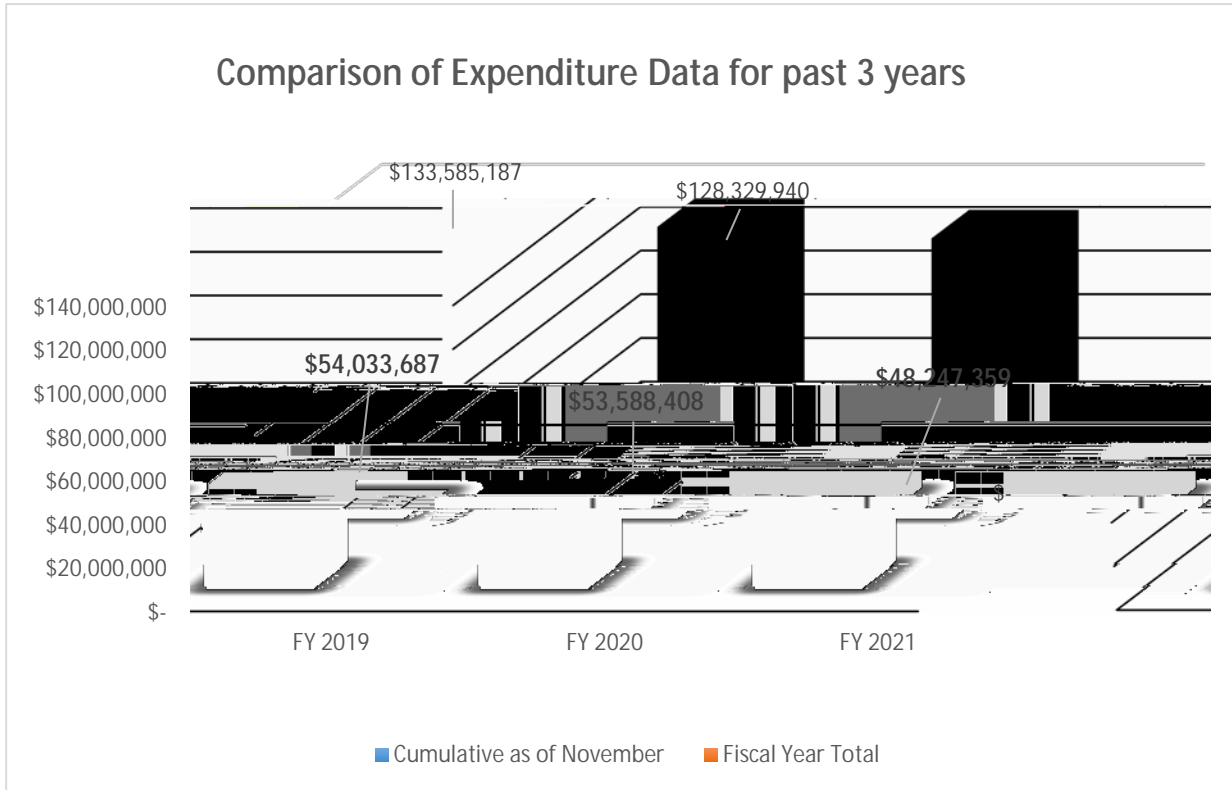
Comparison of Proposal & Award & Expenditure Data for past 3 years
