(Applied Coastal Environmental Science Concentration)

ADMISSION to the B.S. in Coastal Environmental Science curriculum requires that a student be admissible to the College of the Coast & Environment; earned at least 24 semester hours of college credit; have cumulative and LSU GPA of at least 2.0; and have passed all courses in mathematics and science with a "C" or better; or received special approval from the dean of the school.

BASIC SCHOLASTIC EXPECTATIONS

* Maintain a minimum 2.0 Cumulative and LSU GPA

* Maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA in the major field.

* At least 30 of the hours required for this degree must be taken at the 3000/4000 level.
