

Safety Manual > Basic Crane Hand Signals

	<p>– Raise Hoist</p> <p>With forearm vertical, forefinger pointing up, move hand in small horizontal circles.</p>		<p>– Lower Hoist</p> <p>With arm extended downward, forefinger pointing down, move hand in small horizontal circles.</p>
	<p>– Bridge Travel</p> <p>Arm extended forward, hand open and slightly raised, make pushing motion in direction of travel.</p>		<p>– Trolley Travel</p> <p>Palm up, fingers closed, thumb pointing in direction of motion, jerk hand horizontally.</p>
	<p>– Stop</p> <p>Arm extended, palm down, hold position rigidly.</p>		<p>– Emergency Stop</p> <p>Arm extended, palm down, move hand rapidly right and left.</p>
	<p>– Multiple Trolleys</p> <p>Hold up one finger for block marked “1”, and two fingers for block marked “2”. Regular signals follow.</p>		<p>– Move Slowly</p> <p>Use one hand to give any motion signal and place other hand motionless in front of hand giving motion signal (hoist slowly is shown).</p>
	<p>Magnet is Disconnected</p> <p>Crane operator spreads both hands apart, palms up.</p>	<p>The crane operator should only take commands from only one designated person, but, the command of “stop” should be adhered when given by any person.</p>
