Parameters for the PhD Qualifier in ECE

Committee Instructions

- The committee chair submits the completed form to the ECE Graduate Program Office (NOT THE STUDENT).
- 2. The Qualifier is to be approved by the student's PhD supervisory committee of at **least FOUR LSU Graduate Faculty Members**, minus the Dean's Representative (Refer to ECE Graduate Handbook, Section 3.3 for committee guidelines):

ECE PHD COMMITTEE REQUIREMENTS:

At least **FOUR LSU Graduate Faculty Members**, minus the Dean's Representative
At least two members must be from ECE
At least two must be Full Members of the LSU graduate faculty, 1 being from ECE.
The remaining graduate faculty members may be from ECE or other LSU departments if pertinent to the student's area of concentration.

Seminar Presentation: The PhD student will present a seminar to the PhD supervisory (dissertation) committee excluding the dean's representative. The scope of the presentation can be the study of several research papers suggested by the major professor or the report of a project supervised by the major professor. The majority of the committee determines pass/fail. There is no limit of times for the student to make this presentation within the first two years of the PhD study but at most it can be held once every semester.

2.) Publication: Publication can be used as a special track. In principle, one first- authored accepted/published peer-reviewed journal paper or two first-authored accepted/published peer-reviewed conference papers with the affiliation of the ECE Division, LSU, which addresses the research work carried out after joining LSU, can be credited as the substitute the qualifier.
