WHY?

IE's often work with upper and middle management, clients, customers and suppliers, and other disciplines. The ability to communicate effectively is critical to success, and we strongly encourage all eligible dents to pursue the LSU Distinguished Communicator Certificateas evidence to employers of communication skill.

REQUIREMENTS

- x Overall GPA >= 3.0lf your GPA is below 3.0, you can petition to enter the program by submiting a letter explaining why you would make a good Distinguished Communicatorcandidate despite your GPAs well as submitting two of your best communication work samples (writing, speaking, visual, or technological).
- x <= 80 hours of course workompleted For students with over 80 hourscompleted a petition may be made to enter the program if you have at least two semesters remaining before graduation

PROCESS

A <u>detailed checklis</u> is available from the CxC sittene basic process is as follows:

- Attend at least 3 workshopsn improving communication skills (CxC holds them regularly)
- Start taking C(communication intensive)courses
 You must earn a 3.0 or higher in at least 4 CI courses.
 - x Minimum: 3 written, 2 spoken, 1 visual 1 technological (courseare normally certified for at least two modes).
 - x A nonCl course may be considered if the faculty is willing to provide additional communication components and reflection on an individual basis (seeindividual Cl contract)
 - x For IEs, the necessary coursework is normally satisfied by required program courses.
- 4. Start compiling documentation from your courses for your Private Portfolio video of presentations,

- reports, PowerPoint's, technical documents / drawings.
- Select a faculty advisor and complete the advisor/studen contract
- Perform an internship, undergraduate research, or study abroad utilizing communication skills (reflection required).
- Hold a leadership role on campus (student organization or service learning) or within the community. Reflection required.
- 8. Prepare private and public digitabrtfolios of your work.
- Have advisor and CxC committee review your portfolios

DISTINGUISHED COMMINATOR CERTIFICATE AND THEPROGRAM
