

HNRS Course Guidelines

The Ogden Honors College recruits students who are well suited for in-depth and advanced course work. To promote the creation and teaching of courses appropriate for Ogden Honors students, the OHC Faculty Advisory Board offers this document aimed to identify the kinds of general approaches that often distinguish honors courses from other departmental courses and to identify learning outcomes and attitudes or characteristics that are especially descriptive of honors students.

English Composition

A 2000-level honors course may fulfill three (3) hours of the General Education English Composition requirement and should include several writing assignments. One of those assignments should be a research project that includes effective evaluation and analysis of primary and secondary sources.

Learning Outcomes or Skills

Faculty designing an honors course should state on the syllabus what a student should know and be able to do as a result of taking the course. In addition to content-specific, knowledge-
