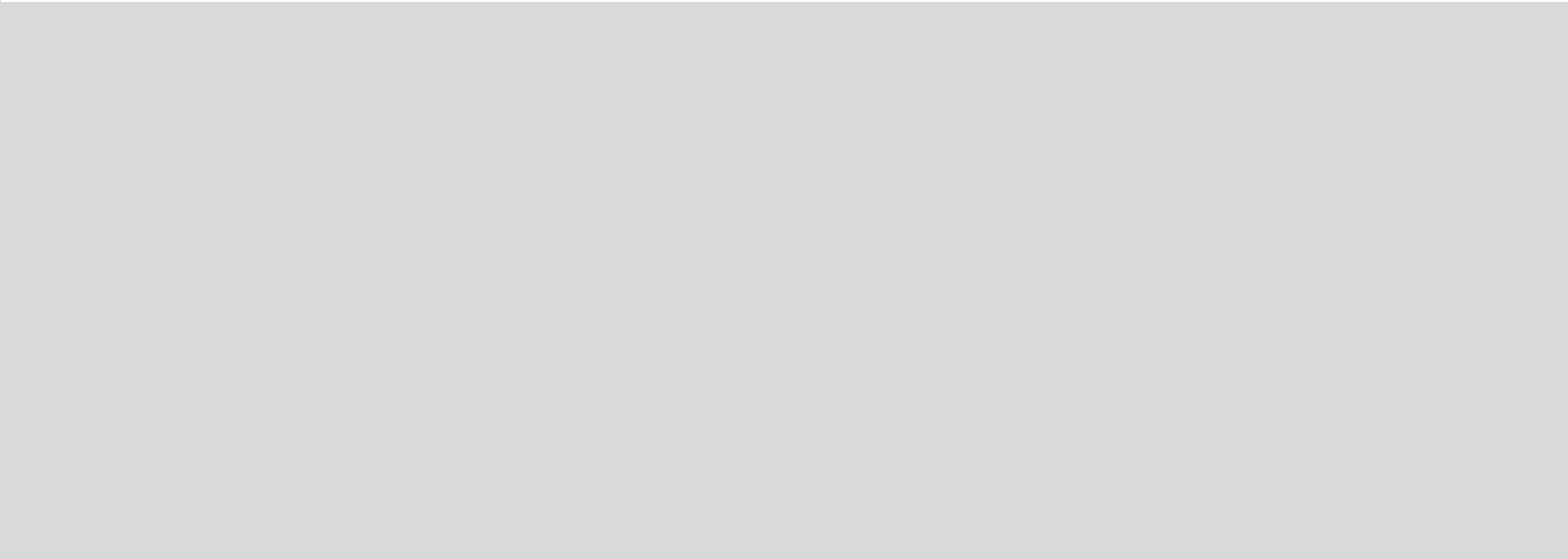

Sabbatical Committee Michelle Zerba

Zerba reminded the Senate that this committee was created last semester by FS resolution to revise PS 12A and noted that the committee examined sabbatical policies at peer institutions around the country and sought to clarify sabbatical eligibility.

Recommendations: extensive revisions of PS 12A (so many that a redlined document is not possible).

Previous version of PS: included instructions the list of those eligible to apply in actual practice, instructors not given sabbaticals, which all led to research. New version closes the gap between paper and practice making it clear that sabbatical eligibility is limited to fulltime tenured faculty who have completed six years of service who have not taken a sabbatical in the last six years (clock starts on first day of job).

The Committee also proposed the following for a FS resolution: *Faculty Senate Sabbatical Review Committee strongly recommends that the Faculty Senate in consultation with the Office of Academic Affairs appoint a committee to establish a periodic leave-with-pay program for Senior Instructors or higher and Professionals-in-*
